



Scheme for Certified Filing Centres (CFCs) to be operated by Members of ICWAI & Firms to facilitate e-filing of various documents under ACES e-Governance Programme of the Directorate General of Systems (Customs & Central Excise)

The Director General of Systems (Customs & Central Excise) is to introduce a scheme for Certified Filing Centres (CFCs) for Automated Customs, Excise and Service Tax (ACES) e-Governance programme for e Filing of various documents similar to MCA-21. In this regard, I had a meeting with Shri Y.G. Parande, Director General of Systems (Customs & Central Excise) on 1st July, 2009 wherein it has been agreed to set up service / facilitation centres across the country and such service can be rendered by our members having requisite infrastructure and knowledge.

It also transpired during the meeting that eligibility and qualification criteria for setting up of Certified Filing Centres shall be similar to those of MCA-21 Project.

The details of the scheme shall be announced to the members shortly as and when the same is finalized by the Director General of Systems (Customs & Central Excise).
